**Starting April 8 and ending May 13th.**

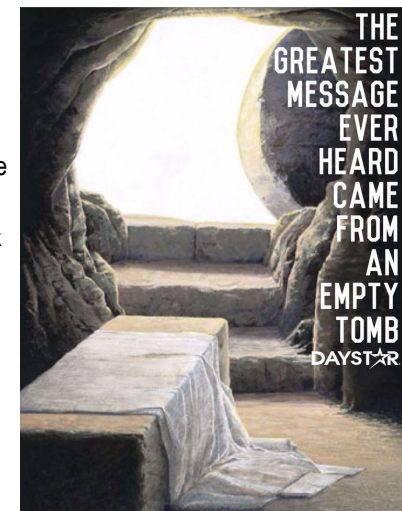
Please sign up for the course in the foyer.
